

Safety Guidelines for Parents and Young People Accessing Online Sessions:

1. In order to ensure the security of the meetings, please DO NOT share the meeting code and password with anyone.
2. It is important that the sessions provide a safe and welcoming environment for all young people accessing them.
3. Parents should use their discretion if they think it is appropriate and safer for them to be with, or in the same room as their child when they are logged on to an online session.
4. Swearing or using language/conversations that would upset other children will be discouraged or stopped by Sarah or Craig.
5. Young people need to be aware everyone should have the opportunity to participate in the sessions.
6. As with the attended sessions at Oak House, the Autism Together Safeguarding Policy and Procedures will be followed if there are any safeguarding issues/concerns during an online session.
