Our Pathway to Work scheme is for people we support who would like to look at employment opportunities and potentially progress to paid employment. These sessions are personcentred and designed to build the skills needed to access a range of jobs. Our Pathway To Work coordinator will work closely with a group of individuals to support them in gaining employment opportunities – this may start with volunteering.



Pathway to work steps

- 1 We will assess if Pathway to Work will improve the independence of a person we support
- 2 Pathways will be tailored to meet the aspirations of people we support and help them achieve their goals
- Our team is passionate about inspiring individuals to learn new skills, achieve their goals, and celebrate their accomplishments through work-related awards and certificates
 - 4 Our team will help people we support to secure the work-experience that is right for them
 - We will help people transition into paid work with employers providing ongoing support
